## *thesis and dissertation*

CHED provides assistance to faculty members who are completing their master's thesis or doctoral dissertation work in any of the cluster of disciplines listed below:

### **For Thesis and Dissertation**

- Science and Mathematics
- Engineering, Maritime Studies and Architecture
- Humanities, Social Science and Communication
- Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry
- Health and Health related Disciplines
- Information Technology
- Teacher Education (except Educational Management)

### **For Dissertation only**

- Business and Industry
- Industrial Technology

## *who may apply*

You may qualify for a thesis or dissertation grant if you are a full time regular faculty member of any higher education institutions (HEIs) in the Philippines and you meet the following criteria/requirements.

### **For Thesis Grant**

- Forty-five years of age or less
- Approved thesis proposal in any of the identified priority disciplines
- Completed the coursework and passed the comprehensive examination in a program recognized as Center of Excellence, Center of Development or with an equivalent accredited level 2 graduate program
- General average of at least 1.75 or equivalent in the required course leading to the master's Degree applied for

### **For Dissertation Grant**

- Fifty years of age or less
- Approved dissertation proposal in any of the identified priority disciplines
- Completed the coursework and passed the comprehensive examination in either a program recognized as Center of Excellence, Center of Development or with an equivalent accreditation level or a graduate education program rated as a Very Good in the CHED Evaluation of Graduate Education in the Philippines (EGEP)
- General average of at least 1.75 or equivalent in the required course leading to the doctoral degree applied for

## *how to apply*

- Secure application form from the Office of the Dean of the Graduate program or from the nearest CHED Regional Office

2. Submit application to the Research Division, OPPRI not later than **January 31 for the first semester and May 31 for the second semester** with the following documents:
  - a) Accomplished application form
  - b) Approved thesis/dissertation proposal with an approval sheet and a one page abstract
  - c) Letter of recommendation for the thesis/dissertation adviser and the Dean of the graduate program
  - d) Endorsement letter from the applicant's mother institution
  - e) Photocopy of the recent enrollment/registration form
  - f) Certification of grades

**Your application for the grant will only be processed if the documentary requirements are complete and submitted on or before the scheduled period for submission**
